Serves as a trusted advisor to senior management in the development of a Company-Wide Security Risk Management Process to ensure best practice control.





Provides recommendations regarding prioritization of systems security investments that mitigate risks, strengthen defenses, and reduce vulnerabilities.

Advises senior management on security trends and evolving security regulations potentially impacting the organization.

Advises on the necessary policies / procedures / processes pertaining to Risk Management.

Drafts and proposes a remediation plan, corrective action plan (CAP), based on the recent risk assessment / GAP analysis / internal risk mitigation.



Understands potential and emerging information security threats, vulnerabilities, and potential control techniques and communicates this information to senior management.





Manages a team of 24By7Security resources responsible for deliverables.
